On the first day of MIRCIM, September 29, the participants can attend the conference Clinical Cases in Internal Medicine: Learning Through Practice, which is part of the prestigious Best Case Report Contest, and also choose from a number of clinical hands-on workshops. MIRCIM 2022 will represent the best qualities of a hybrid event: the possibility to interact in person with colleagues from all over the world, or to attend the event online.
